





The University of East London is offering a 12-week course for refugees and asylum seekers in the UK. The aim of the course is to introduce forced migrants to Higher Education.

It offers an opportunity for students to find out what skills and knowledge are needed in order to apply for and succeed in Higher Education in the UK and provides information about pathways and opportunities.

The course provides in-person and online classes in: English language and academic writing, academic tutoring, presentation and research skills, IT, employability and creative skills. We also offer 1-on-1 mentoring towards applications to study at UK universities and support to apply for scholarships.

A certificate of attendance is available for all who attend the offered workshops.

Next start date is Saturday 5th February. In-person classes will be held at the USS campus in Stratford on Saturdays, and online classes will be held throughout the week TBC.
